SYNOPSIS: On 07/25/07 at approximately 2330 hrs, MCSO Deputies were dispatched to 60 Kunzler Ranch Rd. for a report of an assault. Upon arrival medical personnel were attending to two adult males with serious injuries to their face and arms. Both subjects were immediately taken to the hospital via an ambulance. One subject was airlifted to a hospital out of county because his injuries were life threatening.

One victim positively identified his assailant as Anthony James Pelfrey, who had left the scene in his truck. The truck was later recovered at the South Boat Ramp in Ukiah. Pelfrey's whereabouts are currently unknown.

Sgt. Greg Van Patten of the Detective Unit was notified and his unit was called out to assist with the crime scene.
