SYNOPSIS: On 9-20-2007 an inmate in the Mendocino County Jail (name to be withheld pending next of kin contact) who was being housed in the Medical Isolation Observation Room was observed sitting on the floor unresponsive. Corrections and medical staff responded to the Medical room and initiated CPR (Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation) efforts.

 An ambulance was summoned and responded to the jail and transported the decedent to Ukiah Valley Medical Center where life saving techniques was continued. On 9-20-2007 at approximately 1830 the decedent's death was pronounced.

 The decedent had been an inmate in the Mendocino County Jail since 9-16-2007. On 9-19-2007 the decedent was placed into the medical isolation room due to personal health issues.

 The decedent had been booked into custody for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol involving a traffic accident and Violation of Probation.

 On 9-21-2007 an autopsy was performed. The results of the exam will not be final until toxicology reports have been conducted and forwarded to the coroner's office.
