Who?

Any and all who want to become licensed amateur radio operators.

What?

This is a simplified course which assumes self-study ahead of time in order to take maximum advantage of the course. This is a cram class on how to pass the test.

Who is Offering This Class and Test Session?

The class instructor is Dale Westerterp, WB6TMS from Petaluma. Dale teaches this class several times each year and generally achieves a 90% or better passing rate.

Pre-Requisites?

NO prior knowledge, experience or special skills required. It is recommended that students purchase and study the Gordon West WB6NOA license manual for the question pool starting in July 2010 in advance. Try this link:
